### What is a Gun Free Zone?

A *Gun Free Zone* is a space where no guns or ammunition are allowed, carried or stored.

### How does it work?

It is based on voluntary participation by the whole community and enforced by the organisations and government.

The initial pilot project will have an important impact on all users of the Faraday Taxi Rank. It could also impact on other areas where commuters will visit including soccer stadiums, schools, hospitals and many other public places in and around the Gauteng Province.
